Order of Competition will be Dressage, followed by either of the jumping phases.

**◆ GENERAL CONDITIONS ◆**

1. This event will be run under current Pony Club Association of South Australia general rules relating to One Day Events.
2. The Committee of the Barossa Valley Pony Club reserves the right to accept or reject any entries without entering into any correspondence.
3. Pony Club uniform must be worn in all phases (if a PC rider).
4. Safety Helmets complying with Australian Safety Standard Assoc. ASNZS 3838 and approved boots must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
5. Performance Cards must be current. No card – No ride. Cards must be presented when collecting number and will be held until the end of the competition. Cards must be provided even if riding HC.
6. All riders to supply own body number holders & medical arm bands.
7. Gear inspection will be made prior to each section of the competition, and will include adult riders.
8. The Cross Country Course will be available to walk from 2.00 pm Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> May.
9. NO REFUNDS will be made after the closing date without a Veterinary Certificate.
10. The Committee of the Barossa Valley Pony Club Inc nor the owners of the land accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, rider, groom, spectator or any person whatsoever.
11. Entries are limited, and will be accepted on a "first in" basis.
12. All competitors in Class 1 who complete the event without elimination will receive an encourage ribbon.
13. If eliminated on the Cross Country course, riders must leave the course at a walk and not interfere with oncoming riders.

**NB – the Trakhener jump will not be included in this year's Cross Country Course.**
