Arena size is 80m x 40m

A Freestyle to Music Dressage Test will be offered on March 14th
– requirements for test enclosed

Competition will be open to all drivers. Drivers who are not a member of the EA or an EA affiliated club will be required to pay \$20 Insurance levy per day

The Günter Uellendahl Memorial Award for grooms/supporters will be presented on
February 21st - Angas Harness Driving Club Birthday Rally
(Conditions of eligibility on entry form)

Hot weather policy – *If the forecast for Mt Barker is said to be 36 degrees or over on the Channel 9 news the night before the event, the competition will be cancelled / postponed.*

However – If this occurs for the date of 21st February, the competition will be cancelled, but the birthday celebrations will still proceed as a social event only (i.e. no horses)

- *All drivers compete at their own risk.*
- *The organisers have the right to refuse any entry with or without a reason given.*
- *Hat, gloves, apron, whip and jacket with sleeves (weather permitting) are compulsory.*
- *Plaiting is optional but is not expected for driven dressage days.*
- *AHDC require that all persons travelling on a carriage must wear medical armbands whilst competing.*

All drivers will be required to pencil and will be notified of their times ASAP

Requirements for Freestyle to Music for Carriage Driving

Note: The freestyle tests will be conducted during the lunch break on March 14th. Drivers electing to compete in the freestyle to music, may do so in addition to the maximum of two tests allowed for the day.

1. Time

On entry, the salute at X is optional. The time starts from entry at A. Time finishes with the final salute at the end of the test. Movements performed after the prescribed time will not be scored. Minimum 5 minutes, maximum 6 minutes.

The program selected by the Competitor may not exceed six minutes. The bell will be rung for the first time after five minutes. The bell will be rung again after six minutes to indicate that the Competitor must bring his performance to an end immediately.

2. Music

Competitors supply music on one cassette or CD, clearly labelled and rewound (cassette) to the start of the music. No exit music (i.e. no music after the final salute) is to be included. Music will be turned off at the final salute.

3. Costume

Costume is optional, however, if wearing costume ensure that it is safe and secure and that the horse is used to it.

4. Specifications

Open to all horses and ponies.

Time: 5 - 6mins

Arena: 80 x 40 mtr

5. Movements

a. For movements:

- Walk on the bit - 50m minimum;*
- Working trot - left and right;*
- Lengthened stride at trot; and*
- Circles - must show at least one on each rein with a maximum diameter of 20m.*

b. Points will be awarded in two sections:

Technical execution of movements - 70 points

Artistic presentation - 100 points

Total – 170 points
