GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Each club must nominate one (1) cross country judge for every three riders per club before nomination will be accepted. The name must be shown on the entry form.
2. The committee of the Mount Gambier & Districts Pony Club Inc reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without entering into any correspondence.
3. The committee reserves the right to classify all competitors, divide sections, to restrict entries or cancel a section if necessary
4. Safety helmets complying with AS/NZS 3838, EN1384 or ASTM 1163 standards and riding boots must be worn at all times whilst mounted. This applies to Adult Riders as well as Pony Club Riders.
5. ALL riders must have a gear and safety check before every phase of the competition.
6. No refunds after the closing date.
7. Cards to be presented to Event Secretary before collecting body numbers. Riders must supply their own body numbers holders.
8. Medical armbands MUST be worn for the Cross Country phase.
9. At the discretion of the committee, elimination in one phase will not stop you from competing in following phases.
10. This event is to be run under PCASA rules. The PCASA rules and by-laws will apply for all sections.
11. A second qualified horse may be entered. Competitors may ride a maximum of two horses in each grade. Refer to PCASA Rule 1.7.
12. Camping and yards are available. Portable yards are not permitted. See fees below.
13. Protests are to be in writing no later than 30 minutes after results have been posted in early phases or 10 minutes after final results. Protests are to be accompanied with a \$50.00 fee. Refer PCASA Rule 5.4.
14. Full Pony Club uniform must be worn at the un-mounted presentation. Refer PCASA Rule 5.8.
15. The draw will be emailed to all competitors on Thursday, April 15th 2011.
- 16. DUE TO AIRPORT REGULATIONS DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE MOUNT GAMBIER & DISTRICTS PONY CLUB GROUNDS, ANY PERSON BRINGING A DOG ONTO THE GROUNDS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.**

ENTRIES:

Pony Club entries to be made on the Pony Club Entry Form, and accompanied by entry fees.

Club secretaries are responsible for ensuring that competitor's cards are correctly graded and combinations are qualified.

Pony Club members (up to 26 years of age) require 4 qualifications within the previous 12 months (from date of competition).

If combinations have not obtained 4 qualifications the combination will be able to compete H/C provided a card is produced.

Adult competitors are to enter on the Adult Entry Form and be accompanied by entry fees. Adult riders competing must be current financial members of an Affiliated Pony Club or riders who are not members of a Pony Club must have paid the annual affiliation fee to the State Office and produce their card as proof.

Late entries will incur a \$10.00 penalty per combination and will be accepted only at the discretion of the organising committee.

FEES:

Payment must accompany all entries:

Pony Club Grades \$25.00 per entry

Pony Club Combined Training \$20.00 per entry

Adult Classes \$35.00 per entry

Camping \$10 per rider

Yards are available at \$10 per horse. **NO PORTABLE YARDS ARE PERMITTED**

COURSE CLOSURE:

Schooling of horses is prohibited before, during and after this event. The course will be closed for schooling from 9pm Friday 18th March 2011 and not open again until 7.00am Monday 18th April 2011.

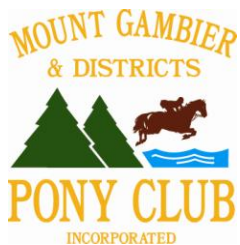

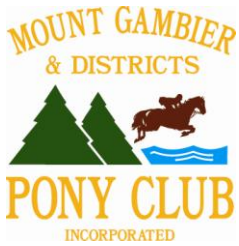

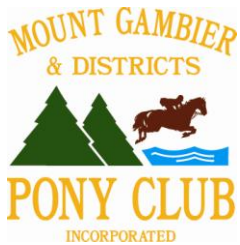

Come for the event & stay for two days of quality instruction from the SA State Eventing Coach

With excellent credentials as both a coach and successful eventing rider, Tracey Leigh will be instructing at a two day eventing clinic following on from our One Day Event. Groups will be limited to 4 riders per group and obviously the clinic will fill quickly so please book your spot early if you wish to participate.

Lessons are available for both the experienced rider and the less experienced rider who is just starting eventing. Riders will receive instruction in dressage, show jumping on the Monday and cross country on the Tuesday.

The cost of the clinic is \$85 per combination. Entries for the clinic will only be accepted with full payment.

Entries close: Wednesday 30th March 2011. Lesson times will be emailed to participants on Thursday, April 15th 2011.

If for any reason you are not able to participate in the clinic entry fees will only be refunded if your place in the clinic can be filled.

It is expected that all riders under the age of eighteen have a guardian in attendance throughout the clinic. Any rider without a guardian will not be allowed to participate.

Camping is available at \$10.00 per rider and yards can be booked at a fee of \$10.00 per horse.
