GENERAL RULES

- No Card—no ride! All performance cards must be current & up to date. Cards must be presented when collecting body numbers.
- All PC entries must have 4 qualifications in card to compete.
- EA members must show proof of membership on the day, and complete PC day membership forms.
- These are available on our event details via AusHorse or via <http://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/membership>
- Riders must supply their own body number holder. A4 body number holders must be worn for XC phase of the competition. Bridle number holders may be used for Dressage & Show jumping phases.
- Pony Club riders must wear full uniform for dressage, show jumping and presentations. Club T shirts may be worn for cross country. Dress for adult riders: as per Pony Club or EFA rules. Medical armbands must be worn.
- Riders who do not present to an arena or start having been twice called to start their competition, will be given a 5 minute warning. If at the end of that time, they do not attend, they will be eliminated.
- AS/NZS 3838; EN 1384 or ASTM F 1163 helmets and smooth soled riding boots must be worn.
- Elimination in one phase does not stop you from competing in following phases BUT, if eliminated on the cross country course, riders must leave the course at a walk & not interfere with oncoming riders.
- Refunds will only be given for withdrawals before the close of entries, unless either a veterinary or medical certificate is produced.
- Competitors may ride a maximum of 2 horses in each grade. A third horse may be ridden HC at the discretion of the organisers.
- There are compulsory gear checks before each phase in all classes.
- The organising committee reserve the right to ballot out entries if numbers warrant, to divide classes if necessary, and refuse entries with or without stating reasons.
- The cross country course will be open from 2pm on 10th March
- All protests must be lodged in writing accompanied by \$20 within 30 minutes of results being posted.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times. No smoking in the vicinity of the clubrooms.

PRESENTATION ETIQUETTE: Presentations are a component of our event.

- All place getters to present in official riding uniform or riding wear.
- Prizes will only be presented to place getters who attend the presentation phase of the event.
- Any place getters wishing to leave before presentations will have chosen to forfeit their prizes.
- Points will still be allocated to relevant place getters.
- Place getters cards will not be returned until after presentations.
- The organising committee will endeavour to hold presentations as soon as possible after the last rider has competed.

THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 18 YARDS AVAILABLE. A \$20 (refundable) bond will be charged to cover costs the club may incur if yards are damaged or not cleaned.
