CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**** Please ensure that you read these rules prior to entering the Show ****

Qualifying Requirements: *No qualification is required to enter this show.*

Eligibility Requirements: *The onus is on the owner/exhibitor/riders to make sure that they and their horse/pony are eligible to compete in this event:*

1. All horses **MUST** be registered with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. National Saddle Horse Register or have pending NSH registration at the close of entries to compete in the Grand National Qualifying classes (e.g. Show Hack, Show Hunter, Rider & Lead Rein).
2. The rider of mounts and owner/leasee of horses competing **MUST** be current financial members of a Show Horse Council Affiliate (e.g. SHC-SA or HIA Comp Assoc. or any other SHC Affiliate Australia Wide) at the close of entries and on the day of competition. Owners of Horses must be a social Member as a bare minimum.
3. Leading Rein for Rider 3 years and under 8 years. Handler (**MUST** be 18 years or over) and rider **must** be a financial member of a SHC Affiliate (e.g. SHC-SA, HIA Competitors Association or another SHC Affiliate) at the close of entries

Rules of Competition: In addition to the rules outlined below all competitors should take note of the SHC Australasia Inc. General Competition Rules, which will apply, unless precluded by rules or conditions of entry specific to this show, the 2012 "Equilibrium Australia" Rising Star Championship Show - Grand National Qualifier. Entry to this competition is voluntary and in entering you agree to accept the rules, terms and conditions of the SHC of Australasia, and its Affiliate, Show Horse Council of SA Inc. The SHC SA Inc. reserves the right to interpret all rules where any dispute arises. Its decision is final.

Entries will be accepted from SHC Affiliate Members Australia Wide for this competition ONLY

Conditions of Entry:

- All horses shall be currently registered with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc, National Saddle Horse Register or with a Breed Register as recognized by the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. (e.g. ASH, ASPA, RSPS, APSB, etc) prior to the closing date of entries. **COPIES OF REGISTRATION TO BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRIES**
- A copy of the membership card **MUST** be included for all owners/exhibitors/riders on the entry form – **ENTRY IS FOR SHC AFFILIATE MEMBERS ONLY**
- Horses / Ponies can only compete as either a Show Hunter or Show Horse – **NOT BOTH**. As of 1/1/2012 this rule is enforced by SHC of Australasia that whatever section you show in for the first SHC show is the section in which you compete for 12 months. There is no change of sections after this first show till the New Year starts on 1/1/2013.
- Proof of age is required for rider classes – riders age is on the day – **PLEASE PROVIDE COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE AS PROOF OF AGE**
- **INCOMPLETE ENTRY** - Should any information, registration papers, height certificates, birth certificates and/ or fees be omitted from the entry, the entry will be deemed incomplete and as such will not be accepted. **A handling fee of \$10 will apply to any entry that is incorrect. This fee will need to be paid prior to competition at the show – otherwise you will be ineligible to start till all fees have been paid.**
- **STABLE REFUNDS** - Refunds on stable bookings will only be given if received in writing and the Show Secretary receives notice of cancellation by the close of entries. **A Handling fee of \$5 will apply to each stable cancelled in accordance with this rule.**
- **NUMBERS** - Numbers corresponding to the catalogue shall be worn in competition. Breastplate numbers on horses in ALL classes, armband numbers for riders entered in RIDER classes. ALL exhibitors (including riders) will be required to pay a NON REFUNDABLE \$2 fee for each breastplate number. Horse entries shall be catalogued as per exhibitor details on the entry form.
- **LIABILITY** - The Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc, Show Horse Council SA and Talunga Park Mt Pleasant shall not be responsible for the loss of, or for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or the property of any exhibitors from any cause what so ever. The exhibitors/competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk.
- **PROTESTS** - All protests shall be in writing to the ground jury accompanied by a fee of \$50 and are to be received no later than one hour after the event, after which time no protest shall be entered in to. Except where any ineligibility is officially proved, the judge's decision is final. A judge's decision representing his / her individual preference can NOT be protested against.
- No outside assistance is to be displayed during competition. Penalty of disqualification may apply to any breach of this regulation.

- **RANDOM SWABBING** - Drug testing may be carried out on both days of the show in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc requirements and Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc competition rules on DRUGS and DRUG TESTING (rules 7.1-7.12) together with the department of sport and recreation doping policy, or in accordance with the relevant laboratory sample collection protocol. Compliance with this rule is mandatory for all exhibits and persons responsible. Drug penalties as adopted in the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc competition rules (7.8a-7.8b) will be apply. Registration papers must be produced if a horse is called up for drug testing.
- **DRUGS** - It is the intention of these regulations that a horse shall perform at the time of competition on their merits, without the aid of drug (s) or prohibited substance (s) which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the horse.
- It is the absolute liability of the owner (s) / exhibitor (s) / responsible officer to ensure that any horse exhibited by them in this competition is free from any prohibited / banned drug or substance at the time of competition. Failure to adhere to this rule may render the exhibit / owner (s) / exhibitor (s) / responsible officer liable to disqualification and / or disciplinary action as determined by the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Results of drug testing may be published.
- The decision as to whether the horse will be permitted to start shall be made by the ground jury. Veterinary advice may be sought if considered necessary. The exhibitor / competitor shall be advised of the decision prior to the commencement time. No (a) claim shall be made against or (b) appeal made to the ground jury or council if, by such decision of the ground jury, the entry is not permitted to start.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse or withdraw any entry / entries without having to assign a reason.
- **INELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS** - All information supplied by the exhibitor (s) and / or owner (s) and / or responsible officer (i.e. the person in charge of the horse) shall be true and correct and represent that the horse / rider is eligible to compete. If information supplied to SHC-SA Inc is found to be false, the exhibit shall be ineligible to compete. **The Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc may discipline the exhibitors and / or owners and / or responsible officer of the entry in question. Should a competitor/exhibitor be found ineligible to compete they MUST return all ribbons, trophies, rugs, and prizes won at the show, so that the prizes can be awarded down the line. Failure to follow these instructions may jeopardise future competition with Show Horse Council and competitors may face further disciplinary measures.**
- Horse entries shall only be accepted where the names and signatures of the current registered owner (s) and / or lessee (s), responsible officers and exhibitors / competitors appear on the entry form. Where an owner of the horse shall be in charge of the horse during the competition, then THAT owner is required to sign the entry form as the responsible officer. If a person other than an owner shall be in charge of the horse during the competition, then THAT person is requires to sign the entry form as the responsible officer. Where a horse is registered and / or entered in the name of a minor (under 18 years), the entry form shall be signed by the parent / legal guardian. **In the event of disciplinary action, the person(s) considered responsible shall be the Owner(s) and / or responsible officer and / or the person in charge of the horse at the time of the offence.**
- The organizing committee and / or the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. and / or the ground jury, reserve the right to alter the numbers of Finalists, Program, Judges, Schedule or Timetable.
- **HEIGHT CERTIFICATE / MEASURING** - All horses **MUST** have a **current Official SHC height certificate** to compete – we recognize **Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. (Provisional, Annual and / or life certificates) ONLY**. Only current SHC Official height certificates will be accepted and it is competitor's responsibility to ensure that their horse has been measured and has a current height certificate prior to the show. **NO MEASURING IS AVAILABLE ON THE DAY –THOSE WITHOUT A CURRENT SHC HEIGHT CERTIFICATE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO START IN COMPETITION.** An **official SHC Show and Measuring day** will be held at Metropolitan Show Jump Grounds, Corner Tapleys Hill Rd & Warren Avenue on **Sunday 15th January 2012 from 10am – 2pm** for competitors needing to be measured, There will also be another **SHC-SA Measuring day** on **Friday 23rd March 2012 from 2pm-4pm at Pegasus Pony Club, Greenwith Rd, Golden Grove** for long distance/interstate competitors and any remaining SA residents to be measured. A timetable will be placed on the website for approx. measuring times for both days on www.shcsa.com.au.
- **A rider shall ride ONLY one horse in each class. This rule will be strictly adhered to.**
- **In rider classes, two riders in the same section CAN NOT ride the same horse.**
- Riders in rider classes under 17yrs are required to wear Jodhpur boots.
- **ATTIRE** - All riders are required to wear a suitable safety helmet (Australian Standards AS/NZ 3838 or EN1384) and approved riding boots at all times. Any breach of this rule, may incur disqualification from the competition. **RIDERS OVER 18YRS MAY COMPETE IN TOP HATS (SHOULD THEY CHOOSE TO DO SO).**
- **EXERCISING HORSES** - **Lunging on the main oval at Mt Pleasant is NOT permitted at any time. Riders must lunge horses outside this area.** Horses may be ridden on the oval prior to competition and in the rings at the discretion of the committee.
- **STABLING** – Bookings and payments for stabling needs to be received as soon as possible. A list of stable allocations will be available at the grounds at the secretary's office and in the stabling area. **Competitors need to organise their own bedding for stabling... Plus remove this at the completion of the show**
- **DOGS** - Dogs **MUST** be kept on a leash **AT ALL TIMES** and under suitable control.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

LED SHOW HACK & SHOW HUNTER CLASSES

Horses entered in the led are to be led in a snaffle or double bridle. No show halters. Horses may only be shown as either a Show Hunter or Show Hack – NOT BOTH. Horses entered in led classes need not be National Saddle Horse registered, but must hold a form of Registration to compete.

NEWCOMER SHOW HACK & SHOW HUNTER CLASSES

For mounts aged 3yrs and over. For show horses or show hunters that have not been shown under saddle in any discipline, except racing, prior to 12th March 2011. All horses are to be ridden in a snaffle bridle. No wilkie or boucher bits. Plain snaffle ONLY. Horses entered in Newcomer classes need not be National Saddle Horse registered, but must hold a form of registration to compete.

NOVICE SHOW HACK & SHOW HUNTER CLASSES

A Novice show horse or show hunter is a horse that has not placed 1st -6th in an individual hack event at a State Capital Royal Show (including 1st-6th placing in a Novice Class at Royal) or been Winner or Runner Up in a Grand National Qualifying Class at a Show Horse Council Grand National Qualifier or Equestrian Australia Horse of the Year National Qualifier Show. Horses entered in Novice classes need not be National Saddle Horse registered, but must hold a form of registration to compete.

OWNER RIDER SHOW HACK & SHOW HUNTER CLASSES

To be ridden by the registered owner and/or immediate family member (e.g. mother, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, etc). Horses entered in Owner Rider classes need not be National Saddle Horse registered, but must hold a form of registration to compete

OPEN SHOW HUNTER CLASSES - GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

Horses ridden in Open Show Hunter of the Year MUST be National Saddle Horse Registered. Winners of Champion and Reserve Champion are eligible to compete at 2013 Grand National Championships in Sydney. Show Hunters work outs will include a gallop.

OPEN SHOW HACK CLASSES - GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

Horses ridden in Open Show Hack of the Year MUST be National Saddle Horse Registered. Winners of Champion and Reserve Champion are eligible to compete at 2013 Grand National Championships in Sydney.

LEADING REIN - GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

A Pony 12.0hh and under, rider to be 3 years and under 8 years on day of show; snaffle bridle only; attendant must fix the leading rein to the noseband; and at all times lead with the rein the left hand; the reins should go directly to the child's hand; string or any aid fastened to the saddle to keep the pony's head in position is not permitted; no spurs or whips; handler may carry a cane; rider should at least be able to rise to the trot; clothing and equipment to be similar to a show pony or show hunter class but NOT judged as a smartest on parade; handler to be suitably attired. Winners of Champion & Reserve are eligible to compete at the 2013 Grand National Championships. Horses competing in lead rein MUST be National Saddle Horse Registered.

RIDER CLASSES - GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

At Shows conducted in accordance with the Show Horse Council Rules, the Mount of a Rider used in a Rider under Nine years Competition shall be restricted to not exceed a height of 14.0hh. The Mount of a Rider in a Nine years and under Twelve years Competition shall be restricted to not exceed a height of 14.2hh. Winners of Champion and Reserve Champion are eligible to compete at 2013 Grand National Championships. Mounts used for rider classes MUST be National Saddle Horse Registered.

SHOW HORSE COUNCIL "CLASSIC" CLASSES

Show Horse Council SA Classic Classes are an initiative of the Show Horse Council of SA Inc and are an incentive to get SA Competitors out to support our smaller royal show qualifying shows. In order to compete in these classes horse must have been the winner of a Champion or Reserve Champion Award under saddle in either the Show Hack or Show Hunter Section at one of our shows during the 2011/12 season. Horses competing in SHC Classic classes need not be registered but must have been met the qualification to compete in the class.
