**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. All Exhibits must be registered with The Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc and in the name of a current Financial Member.
2. All Exhibits must adhere to the current Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc Showing Standard.
3. Branding: Ponies must be branded before being shown, but Foals under the age of eight months, being shown Independent of their dams are excluded. However, irrespective of age, if a Foal has been sold by the breeder, it MUST be branded.
4. All handlers must be suitably attired in the ring.
5. Copies of relevant Registration Papers and Foal Recordings (both sides, if relevant) MUST be sent in with the Entry Form and carried with you on the day of the Show. You should also carry your Membership Card with you.
6. Age of Exhibit is at 1 August, preceding the date of the Show.
7. Age of Handler is at the day of the Show ~ NOTE: Junior Members stay in same age category for entire season.
8. Junior Handlers must be Members of The Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc in their own right, or part of a Joint Membership.
9. All Foals to be led by a competent Member; Colt Foals can only be led by a competent Member, 18 years & over.
10. Broodmares to have foal at foot.
11. ALL Entires, 2 years and over, must be shown in a bit.
12. ALL Entires, irrespective of age, can ONLY be handled by a competent Member, 18 years and over.
13. Harness: It is a requirement of our Rules that ALL Harness exhibitors and passengers, MUST wear an approved helmet conforming to the current safety standards. The Helmet must meet ASNZ3838 (or equivalent European EN1384 or USA ASTM1163) and must not be greater than 5 years of age from date of manufacture or have sustained a severe impact. Driven exhibits must be 3 years and over.  
Drivers in Harness Classes who are 17 years and under MUST be accompanied by a competent adult (who also must be a Member and wear an approved helmet).
14. All protests must be lodged with the Show Convener within 15 minutes of the completion of the Class, together with a \$50-00 fee, which will be reimbursed if the protest is upheld. The Show Dispute Committee's decision will be final. NO PROTEST WILL BE HEARD WITHOUT THE \$50-00 FEE BEING PAID.
15. No refund of fees will be given – under any circumstances.
16. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up all manure and rubbish from around their floats, cars or any area they occupy on the grounds. The owner of the grounds will on-charge any cleaning expenses to Members not adhering to this condition.
17. Members are reminded that they are responsible for Non-Members who accompany them and that they can be disciplined by the Federal Committee if the behaviour of those persons warrants such action. This ruling also applies to Members who bring The Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc into disrepute.
18. Neither the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc nor the SA Promotional Group, nor the owner of the grounds, will accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or loss to ponies, exhibitors or spectators or any of their belongings or any other persons or property whatsoever.
19. Photographs will be taken at these Shows and maybe published in relevant media outlets as part of a record of the Shows. In signing the Entry Form, you are agreeing to the publication of said photos. If you do not wish to have your Pony photographed, you must advise the Delegate, in writing prior to the Show. If you have previously advised the Delegate this instruction will stand, until advice to the contrary is received in writing from the Member.
20. Members are required to sign their own Entry Forms. If ponies are being entered by other than the Registered Owner, a letter of authority MUST be provided. In the case of jointly owned ponies, one signature is acceptable.
21. Entry Fees: as per relevant Show Schedule and Entry Form.
22. ALL Ponies entered in the Championship Show MUST be measured before being shown. Please bring original Registration Certificates when being measured. ***Measuring will be done between 7-30am and 8-00am.***
