

Cross Country & Show Jumping Training Day

Sunday, 19th February, 2012

Mildura Alcheringa Pony Club grounds, Racecourse Rd, Mildura



Cross Country starts at 9am. Course walk open from 8am, all fences flagged/numbered, maps provided. Combinations to start at set intervals in grade of their choice. XC timed, but jumps not recorded. Limited to one XC start per horse, however, opportunity to train at individual fences on completion of all XC rounds. Show Jumping will start at 45cm at 9am and be raised by 15cm after each round. No results recorded, training day only. \$10 day fee for non PCAV riders. Contact below for full conditions of entry.

Grade 1 / PreNovice - 105cm

Grade 2 / Preliminary - 90cm

Grade 3 / Introductory - 75cm

Grade 4 - 60cm

Grade 5 - 45cm

Conditions of Entry

Riders who are not members of PCAV must pay a \$10 day fee. **ALL** riders must complete a day attendance form before riding. *Complete form on the day or bring completed form with you: www.ponyclubvic.org.au Resources – Forms – Club Membership – Day Attendance Form*

Medical arm bands and back protectors are **compulsory** for XC.

Gear Check conducted before commencement of XC or SJ. Approved helmets and footwear must be worn at all times.

No stallions, colts or rigs.

BBQ lunch at 12noon - \$5 for meal and drink.

Lungeing is only permitted within the round-yard.

Once the XC rounds are complete, individual fences can be trained.

Riders must be **supervised** by a person over the age of 16years at this time. Please be courteous to other riders when training and do not over crowd jumps – i.e. the water jump.

SJ will commence at 45cm and be raised by 15cm after each round.

Maximum two rounds per height, per horse. No formal limit on overall number of SJ rounds.

No refunds on un-used tickets.

Dogs allowed, must be kept on leash at all times.

Yards available, **must** be kept clean. \$15 fee if rails are broken.

Dressage arena available for use at rider's discretion.

Privately organised instructors welcome.

Neither the MAPC Inc, Mildura Horse Complex Inc, Board of Management or PCAV accept any liability for any accident, injury, loss or illness to any horse, rider, owner, spectator or any other persons involved what so ever.

All entrants must be familiar with the Horse Abuse Policy per PCAV's Handbook of By-Laws – any behaviour deemed inappropriate will result in disqualification from the day's events.
