Combinations may compete at the level on their dressage card and/or one grade above.

Combinations may only compete at a maximum of 2 tests on the day (EA & / or PC) EA Classes do not qualify for the Southern Zone Dressage Series.

All tests are to be run in a 60 x 20m arena.

JCPC Dressage Series Event Information

Open to Pony Club members, PCASA State Adult and EA members.

PC classes are open to Pony Club members only.

Southern Zone Dressage High Points Series only open to Southern Zone PC Members

The event is run under the rules and regulations of PCASA: <https://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/rule-book>.

Pony Club Riders must bring their PC card. EA riders must show their current EA membership card and sign a waiver.

BYO water for your horses.

No yards available.

Approved helmets with PCASA tag, gear and riding boots must be worn by all Pony Club Riders

Gear check is compulsory for ALL riders.

Any event updates will be posted on the Jupiter Creek Pony Club Facebook page.

The committee reserves the right to alter the program without further notice and refuse or accept any entry without stating a reason.

Calling of tests is discouraged but may be allowed where special circumstances exist. Please advise when presenting to the judge before your test if you need to have the test called.

- **You MUST have an official PCASA dressage card to compete.**

Dress Code / Approved Gear

PCASA Classes - Official Pony Club uniform; Club shirt and tie, jumper (unless summer dress declared on the day), Jodhpurs as per club uniform. Approved helmet and boots must be worn (new helmet rule applies). If gaiters/chappettes/leggings are worn they should be the same colour as the riding boot.

EA Classes – Dressage Jacket, Competition shirt (unless summer dress declared in which competition short sleeve shirt is allowable) EA approved helmet and boots.

All tests must be ridden in a snaffle. Martingales are not permitted. Protective boots on the horse's legs are not permitted.

Dressage whips can be carried. Gloves are optional. Plaiting of horses is optional. Body or saddlecloth/bridle numbers are not required, please present to the judge before your test and give your name and your horse's name.

2024 Southern Zone Dressage High Points Series – PCASA Classes only

Awards will be presented at the last fixture of the Series to the combination with the highest points in each of the dressage levels (prep, prelim, novice, elementary and medium). 1 point will be awarded for riding in the test, and first to 6th placings will earn additional points.

Riders should nominate at the beginning of the series which horse they want to earn points for (if riding more than one horse only one can be eligible for a High Point award). The same horse may be ridden at 2 consecutive levels (e.g. if a combination is graded Prelim on their card, they can compete in both the Prelim and Novice tests) but a combination can only win a High Point award at one level. Combinations must be qualified for points to count.
