ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Rules and Regulations

- 1) This event will be run under PCASA Inc rules www.ponvclub.asn.au it is up to riders to be aware of the rules.
- 2) All persons attending must 'check-in' using the QR Code or sign in form provided.
- 3) Gear check is compulsory for all riders (including EA riders). Please present to the gear checker before warming up and at least 15 mins before your test. If you do not have a gear check, you will be eliminated.
- 4) Copies of dressage tests are available on PCASA website <http://www.ponvclub.asn.au/documents/dressage-tests>
- 5) All riders must be members of a Pony Club, proof of membership to be presented to the office on arrival.
- 6) EA riders must be current financial members of EA. Complete the PCASA waiver for EA riders at Pony Club events and include with event entry. Pay the PCASA EA Levy \$16 (per rider) with other event entry fees. Proof of payment must accompany entry.
- 7) The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry, vary the conditions of any class, cancel, add or combine any event at their discretion.
- 8) Neat Casual Riding Attire. PCA Approved Boots and Helmets with up to date tag must be worn.
- 9) Refunds of event entry fees will only be given for withdrawals before the close of entries, unless either a veterinary or medical certificate is produced. Please allow 2 weeks for processing.
- 10) Behavior deemed inappropriate to fellow competitors, officials, visitors, or horses may result in elimination. If a mount is deemed dangerous during the event it may result in elimination
- 11) All protest must be lodged in writing to the event secretary (not the disputes committee) accompanied by the \$50 fee. All protests must be lodged within thirty minutes of results being posted.
- 12) Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds spectators or any other person.
